

**VILLAGE OF BERRIEN SPRINGS
ORDINANCE NUMBER 392**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10
ENTITLED "ANIMALS", Section 10-2

NOW THEREFORE, The Village of Berrien Springs ordains:

Section 1. Section 10-2 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following new Subsection 10-2:

Section 10-2 - Keeping of livestock and all farm animals, except chickens is prohibited.

It shall be unlawful to own, harbor, keep, maintain or raise any and all livestock and farm animals of any kind, except chickens (hens only) in reasonable numbers, in a clean and sanitary manner. Roosters within the Village are prohibited.

Section 2. Any and all other parts, sections or clauses contained in said Ordinance not otherwise amended by this Ordinance are hereby ratified and affirmed and remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance and its various parts, sections and clauses are hereby declared several. If any part, section or clause contained in this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or otherwise legally invalid, it is hereby provided that the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. The Village Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after publication.
