The Village of Berrien Springs has a history as rich as its name! Incorporated in 1863 though some records suggest 1867 the village, along with Berrien County, was named in honor of John MacPherson Berrien. Berrien was a distinguished lawyer, U.S. senator, and even served as the U.S. attorney general under President Andrew Jackson.

But what about the "Springs" in Berrien Springs?

That addition came in April 1836, thanks to merchant R.E. Ward, who requested the name change after mineral springs were discovered in the area. These springs were once believed to have health benefits, making the village a notable spot in Michigan's history!
